## COMMON PRESCRIBING ERRORS (Part 2)



# WRONG

## FORMULATION

### **Insulin Actrapid**

#### Common error:

Ordering insulin Actrapid **VIAL** instead of insulin Actrapid **PENFILL** upon discharge

#### What's the difference?:



Actrapid VIAL (10mL) → only for <u>inpatient</u> use



Actrapid PENFILL (**3mL**) → for <u>outpatient</u> use

#### To prevent error:

Choose the correct formulation in the system

(Vial- inpatient use, Penfill - outpatient use)

### Metformin

#### Common error:

	Wrong	Correct
4	Metformin XR 1 Tab BD/TDS	Metformin 1 Tab BD/TDS
	Metformin 1500mg OD	Metformin XR 1500mg OD

#### What's the difference:



Metformin XR (extended -release)

#### Metformin XR →

Extended-release (XR)

→ slower absorption in
the body → suitable for
higher doses like 1.5g
but **Only OD dosing** to
reduce GI-related
adverse effects



#### **Metformin** →

Immediate-release (IR)

→ Faster absorption in
the body → suitable for
OD/BD/TDS/QID dosing



#### To prevent error:

Order the right formulation (Just Metformin for immediate release & Metformin XR for extended-release)

METFORMIN HCL 500MG EXTENDED RELEASE TAB (GLUCOPHAGE XR -)G)

METFORMIN HCL 500MG TAB (GLUCOPHAGE-G) → Immediate-release

formulation
